## 1. Preamble

- 3.1 Your personal information will only be used for purposes of ensuring that you have the best experience of being connected with the Hall and of using our Hall and its facilities.
- 3.2 We will not share your information with any outside parties unless we contact you, for your permission, beforehand.

#### 4. Security

4.1 We will take all reasonable precautions to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of information you give us.

4.2 Communications about bookings and about our Hall and its facilities will be sent by post, by e-mail or posted on our website. For ease of use and compatibility, our communications with you will not be encrypted and may therefore not be fully secure. Whilst we endeavour to keep our systems and communications protected against viruses and other harmful effects, we cannot bear responsibility for all these communications being virus-free.

#### 5. Cookies
